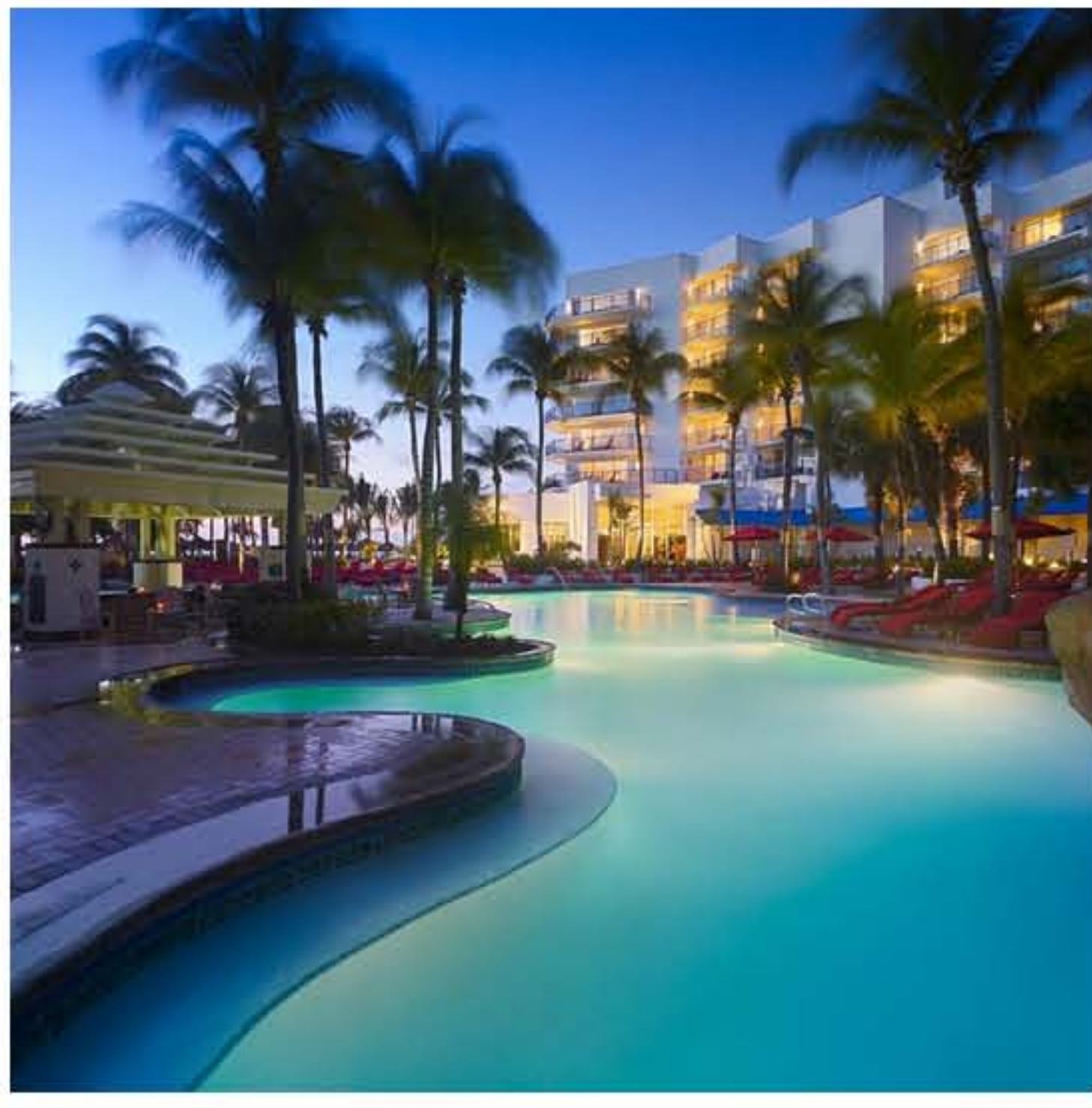
Deals of the week: Cyber Monday edition
